Legal stuff the lawyers make us say: Alabama State Board evaluates Excelsior graduates on a case-by-case basis. Contact the state board for details. Arizona State Board requires Excelsior students to complete 120 hour precepted experience set up by Excelsior College, after finishing the ADN requirements, students may endorse into the state with 960 RN hours. California State Board declares that all Excelsior ADN graduates may apply for endorsement on a case-by-case basis. Contact the state board for details. Colorado State Board ASN Graduates sitting for boards: Anyone registered before January 1, 2006 will be grandfathered in with no changes. Others will be required to perform additional clinical hours. Florida and Louisiana State Board requires Non-LPNs to meet certain guidelines. Georgia students need to contact their State Board for the current regulations. Kansas Residents: Check with the Kansas State Board of Nursing about additional clinical hours needed. Kentucky State Board requires graduates of all nursing schools do a 120 hour preceptorship upon completion of the nursing program. Maryland students need to contact their State Board for the current regulations. North Dakota State Board states all graduates may endorse in with 400 hours of RN experience. Oklahoma State Board requires students to pass two 30-hour precepted experiences in Psych and OB given by Excelsior College before graduation. Vermont Residents and Excelsior College: You will need to take your state boards outside the state of Vermont and work 480 clinical hours before you can transfer your RN licensure into the state of Vermont. Washington State Board states that only LPNs with 200 hour precepted experience set up through a Washington Nursing Commission approved facility may apply for examination. Graduates who were originally LPNs may endorse in with minimum 200 hours RN experience. All non-LPN graduates with RN experience may be denied endorsement and will have to appeal any denial. Canada Nurses: Only LPN's qualify for the Excelsior College program if they reside in Canada.



ASN and BSN license requirements

The Excelsior College ASN and BSN degree programs are completely independent study except for the clinical evaluation(s). These external degree plans allow qualified students to earn most of their degree without sitting in a classroom. Students must already have a license in the medical field to participate. If you are enrolled in a different nursing program, check with the admissions office for their requirements. Below is a list of the licenses accepted by Excelsior College for ASN or BSN eligibility.

Excelsior enrollment fees

If you are pursuing your degree from Excelsior, at some point you will need to enroll. As with other colleges, there are fees associated with enrollment.
